- Laveen's Governing Board voted to transition to virtual learning on November 30, 2020. We expect this to continue until winter break which begins on December 18.
- Some student rosters changes will occur after break based on staffing and school choices for 3rd and 4th quarters via the parent survey that was recently sent out. If there is a change to your child's homeroom teacher for the 2nd semester, this will be communicated by December 11th from the new teacher. We did our best to limit changes in order to keep consistency for your child.

During the winter break, a five-day bundle of food will be distributed on Wednesday, December 23 and 30 at Desert Meadows School. (time to be determined)


