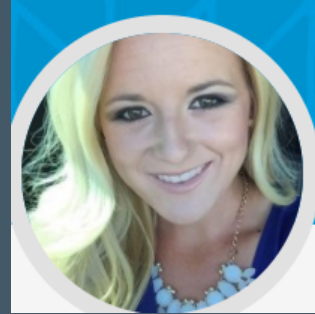


TSP **Panther Distance Learning** **P.A.C.T. Matrix**

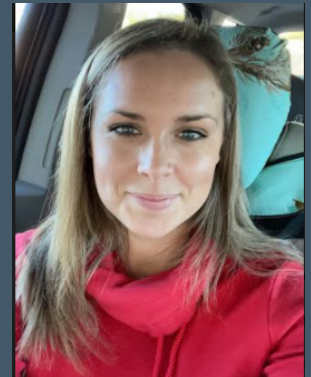


Lauren Barnes

Suzanne always jumps right in to help where needed. She cares about each individual student and always puts a smile on everyone's face! Congratulations, Suzanne!

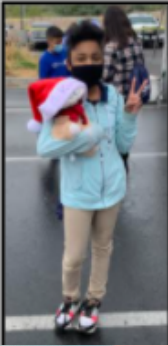


3rd Quarter Curriculum Pick-up

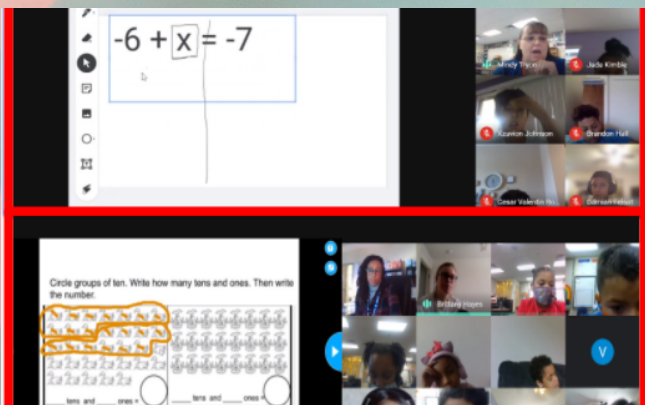


ENCOURAGING *Reading*
