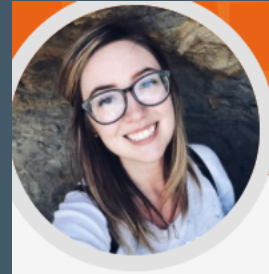
SLIME!
