Ms. Cortez is always willing to lend a helping hand and support where needed. She provides students with a listening ear and truly cares about all students. Congratulations, Veronica!



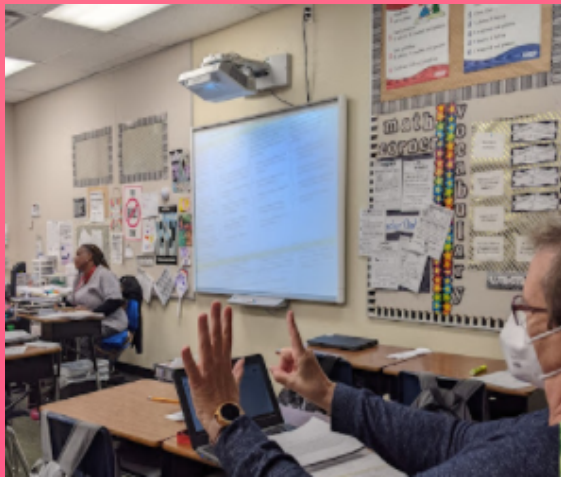
Fragile Planet Wildlife Park came to Trailside with animals! Students had an opportunity to take a picture with them as well. What an exciting presentation!



8TH GRADE GEARS UP FOR HIGH SCHOOL

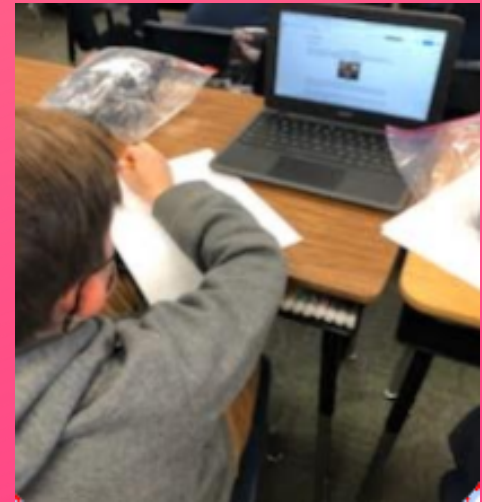


Betty H. Fairfax visited our 8th graders to talk to them about getting ready for High School!
