Dear Parents and Guardians,

The second quarter is off to a wonderful start! A part of our school integrated action plan and theme for this year is focused on different cultures, values, and communities. Since returning from Fall Break, our students have learned so much about the Italian and Native American heritages.

We began by commemorating Italian Heritage Month. Every day over the morning announcements, our students learned a few interesting facts about Italian heritage and customs. Here are a few of the facts that were shared:

- **Italian Cuisine** - Each region in Italy eats different foods. For example, the most internationally popular Italian dishes originate from Italy. Pizza and pasta are known as just 2 of the most popular dishes.
- **Italian Currency** - The lira was the official currency of Italy between 1861 until January 1st, 1999, when it was replaced by the now official currency, the euro. One euro equals 0.98 U.S. dollars.

The month of November is celebrated annually as Native American Heritage Month. So far, our students have learned the following:

- 9.1 million people identify as Native American or Alaskan Native. There are 574 federally recognized American Indian and Alaska Native tribes and villages.
- It wasn't until 1924 that Native Americans were granted citizenship after Congress enacted the Indian Citizenship Act. While Native Americans were given the right to vote, it took another 40 years for all 50 states to allow voting rights.

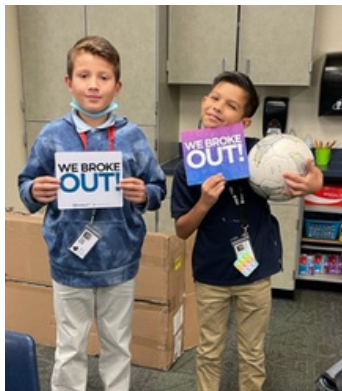

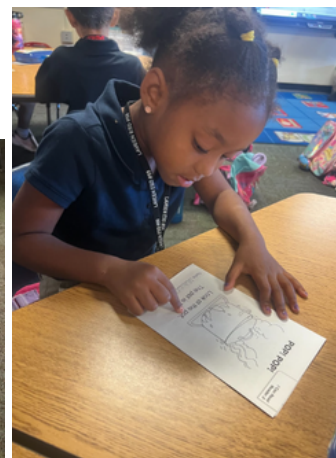


Our Gifted students worked hard in groups on break-out activities!

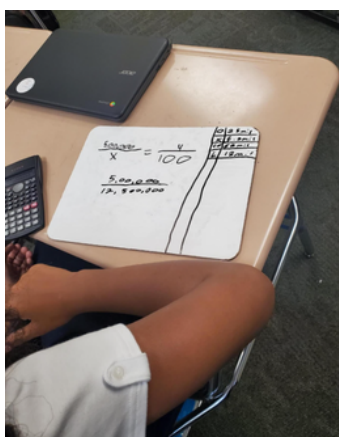


K-8 teachers held data assemblies! They shared data and discussed ways to grow throughout the school year!

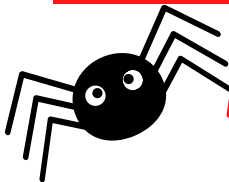

SCHOOL UNIFORM

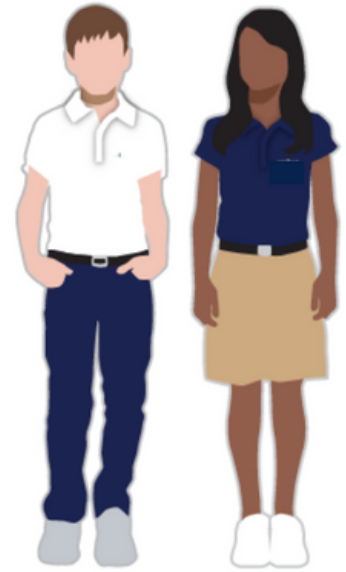
Please review the Laveen School District's uniform policy with your child(ren).

Shirts/Tops: Short-sleeves or long-sleeves in solid white, navy blue or light blue. Polo-style, blouses, or button down with collars. No logos. No t-shirts. Fridays are our spirit days and can wear red polos or our PACT spirit shirt.

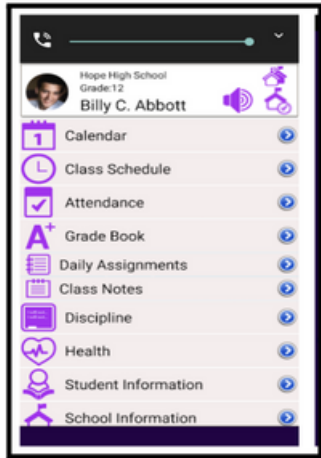

PARENTVUE WEBSITE AND PHONE APP

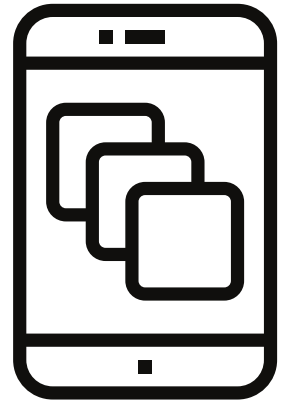
