In the month of April, Laveen School District students will participate in state achievement testing. Students in grades third through eighth will take the AASA, Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment. The AASA test measures students' skills in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics. Students in grades fifth and eighth will also take the AzSCI, Arizona Science Test.

**Student attendance is very important**, not only during testing but also in the next several weeks as we review and reinforce important skills and standards that students will need to achieve success. Below you will find a list of ways that you can help your student do their very best on their AASA test:

- Make sure your student gets a good night's sleep.
- All children should eat a good breakfast either at home or at school.
- It is important that your student arrives at school on time, so they do not miss any parts of the essential instruction or the test.
- Make any appointments before or after school hours.
- Send your student to school with a positive attitude. Encourage them to do their best. Let them know how wonderful you think they are!

We want our Trailside Point Panthers to show their very best on their test, and we know that our students can do just that! **Here at Trailside, we will have raffles throughout the testing window!** Students will earn testing tickets from trying their best, in which they can enter into raffles to earn different items such as a new bike, earpods, wireless speakers, free dress downs, and more!

K-2 students do not take AASA, however, it is still crucial that they are at school each and every day as well! We do not want them to learn out on learning opportunities as they begin the fourth quarter of learning and the final preperation for next year!







#### SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please review the Laveen School District's uniform policy with your child(ren).

**Shirts/Tops:** Short-sleeves or long-sleeves in solid white, navy blue or light blue. Polo-style, blouses, or button down with collars. No logos. No t-shirts. Fridays are our spirit days and can wear red polos or our PACT spirit shirt.

**Pants/Skirts/Bottoms:** Pants or shorts in solid black, navy blue or khaki. Dresses, jumpers, or skirts in solid black, navy blue or khaki. No jeans. No sweatpants. No leggings.

**Outerwear/Jackets:** Jackets, sweatshirts or sweaters in solid navy blue, white, gray, or light blue. Outerwear must be worn over an approved uniform shirt.

**IDs & Lanyards:** School-issued IDs and lanyards are considered part of the required school uniform and must be worn daily.
