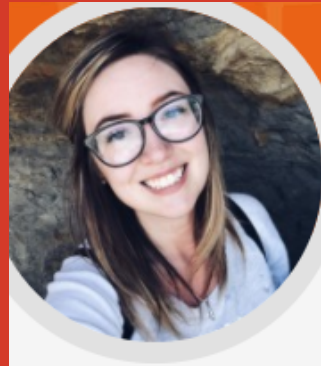

Melissa Potts

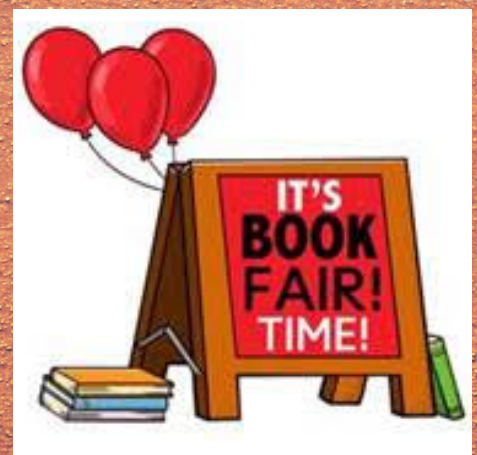
